GLOBALLY CONNECTED

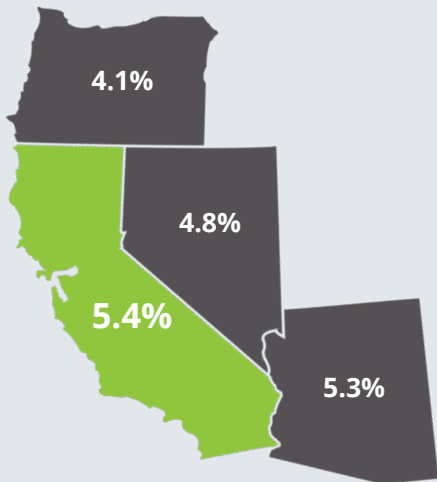
Among all international employers, those from the **United Kingdom, Japan** and **Germany** support the largest number of jobs in California.

MANY EMPLOYERS

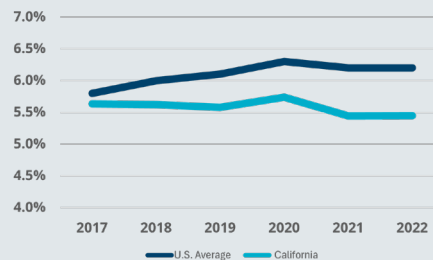
2,822 international employers have operations in California.

FDI Jobs as a % of Total Employment

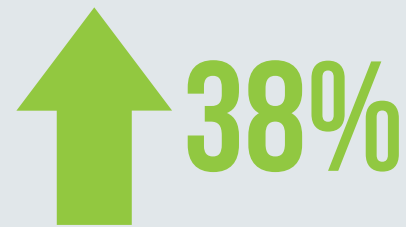


California vs. USA
