Among all international employers, those from the **Netherlands**, the **United Kingdom** and **Germany** support the largest number of jobs in Connecticut.

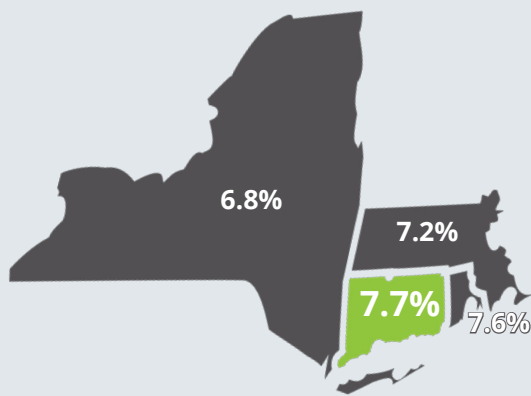
MANY EMPLOYERS

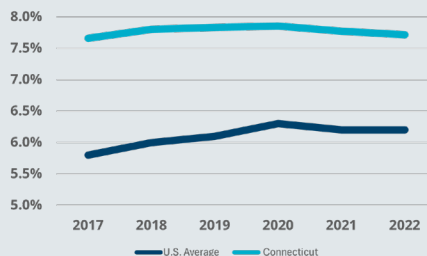
Connecticut vs. Its Neighbors
