66,800 workers in Massachusetts - **28 percent** of all FDI jobs in the state - are in the **manufacturing sector**.


GLOBALLY CONNECTED


Among all international employers, those from the **United Kingdom**, the **Netherlands** and **France** support the largest number of jobs in Massachusetts.
