Among all international employers, those from the **United Kingdom**, the **Netherlands** and **France** support the largest number of jobs in Massachusetts.

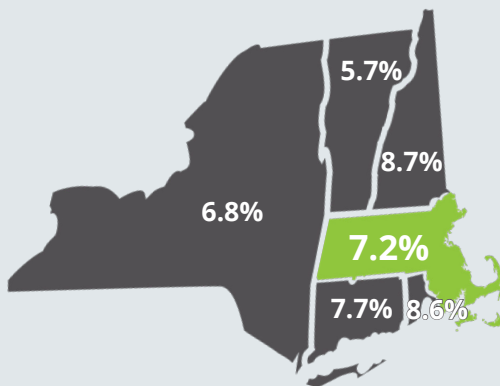
MANY EMPLOYERS

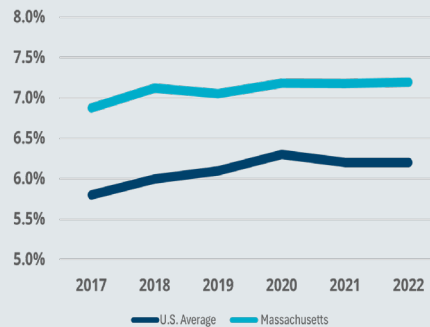
Massachusetts vs. Its Neighbors
