GLOBALLY CONNECTED

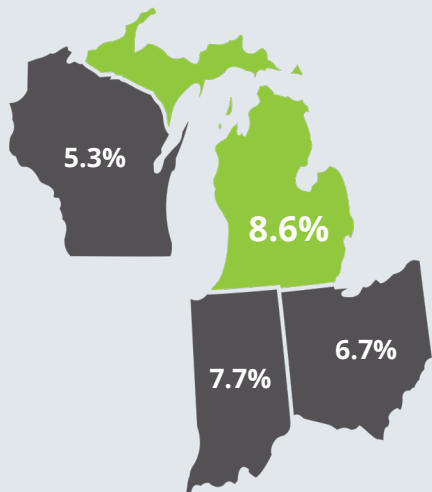
Among all international employers, those from **Germany, Japan** and the **Netherlands** support the largest number of jobs in Michigan.

MANY EMPLOYERS

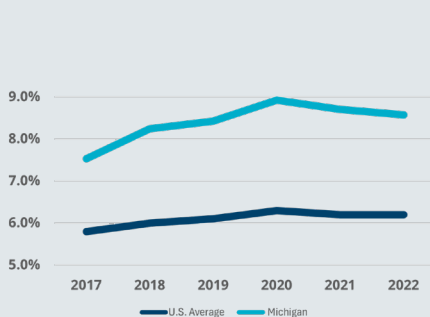
