GLOBALLY CONNECTED

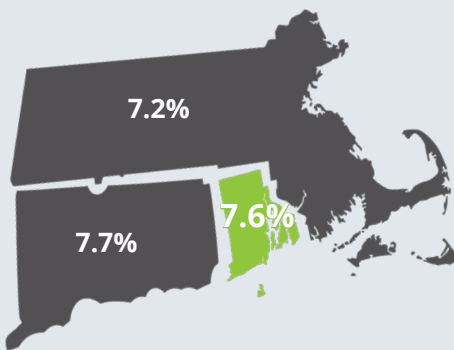
Among all international employers, those from **Netherlands, France** and the **United Kingdom** support the largest number of jobs in Rhode Island.

MANY EMPLOYERS

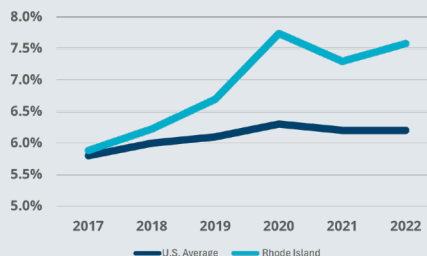
