GLOBALLY CONNECTED

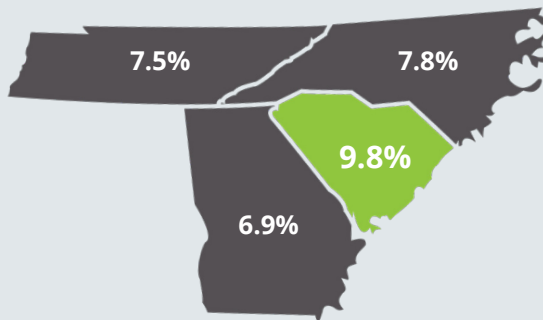
Among all international employers, those from **Germany, France** and **Canada** support the largest number of jobs in South Carolina.

MANY EMPLOYERS

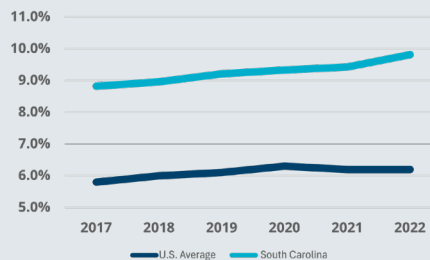
947 international employers have operations in South Carolina.

FDI Jobs as a % of Total Employment

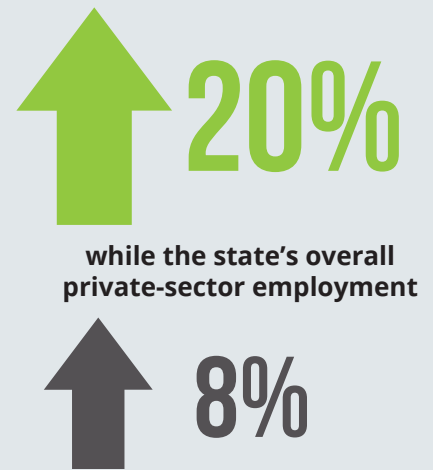


South Carolina vs. USA
