194,700 workers in Texas - **28 percent** of all FDI jobs in the state - are in the **manufacturing sector**.


GLOBALLY CONNECTED


Among all international employers, those from the **United Kingdom**, **Japan** and **Canada** support the largest number of jobs in Texas.
