GLOBALLY CONNECTED

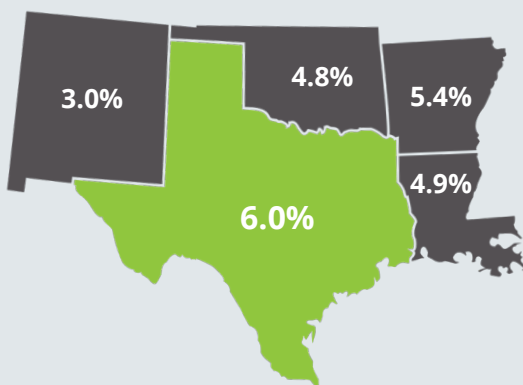
Among all international employers, those from the **United Kingdom, Japan** and **Canada** support the largest number of jobs in Texas.

MANY EMPLOYERS

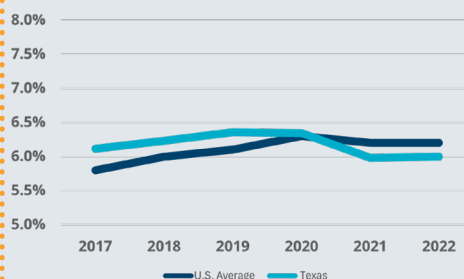
2,169 international employers have operations in Texas.

FDI Jobs as a % of Total Employment

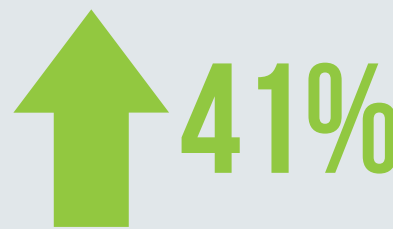


Texas vs. USA
