GLOBALLY CONNECTED

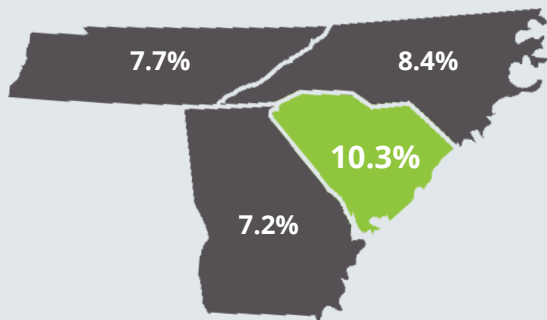
Among all international employers, those from **Germany, France** and **Canada** support the largest number of jobs in South Carolina.

1,024 international employers have operations in South Carolina.

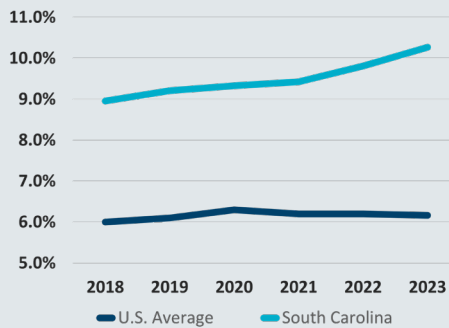
